Public Compliance Statement

RSG aims to comply with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public. If, in the future we seek donations from the public, we will also aim to comply with the Guidelines in this regard.

- RSG is committed to complying with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising and has formally discussed and adopted the Statement at a meeting of the governing body.
- RSG confirms its commitment to the principles set out in the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising by a statement to that effect in its annual report.
- RSG has a Donor Charter which is consistent with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising.
- RSG regularly monitors compliance with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising and compliance reports are received regularly by the governing body.
- RSG considers the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising when planning all fundraising activity.
- RSG provides honest, open and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public.
- RSG has appointed a member of the governing body and/or a senior member of staff to be responsible for compliance with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising.
- RSG ensures that fundraising staff are provided with information and training on the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising and its implementation.
- RSG has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising. Feedback is recorded for review by relevant staff including the CEO and governing body. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.
- RSG prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.
- RSG ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and complies with data protection requirements.
- RSG is accessible to the public through a number of readily available contact options.

RSG is in the process of completing the compliance record for the Charities Governance Code and aims to have the record completed, agreed to and signed off by the board before the end of 2019.
